The Bronx County Hall of Justice stands prominently on its two-block site facing East 161st Street near the borough's Grand Concourse. The building houses 47 court parts, seven grand jury rooms, and administrative office suites for contract agencies and the District Attorney. It also provides underground parking for 240 vehicles. Fitting the building into the surrounding community was important during the design process. The L-shaped structure forms the edges of a public courtyard, reinforcing the commercial street wall and embracing neighboring communities with an open and engaging civic plaza.
